



4000 - ARUGULA (ROQUETTE)

A spicy spinach-like salad green with a delicious nutty flavour. Loves cooler weather. A favourite for salads. Grows to 1m (3').

4005 - YELLOW BEAN GOLDEN WAX

50 days *Heirloom*

Smooth, slightly curved, yellow pods 12-15cm (5-6") long, on prolific plants. Good disease resistance. Black seed/white eye.

4010 - GREEN BEAN TENDERGREEN

50 days *Heirloom*

Straight, stringless green pods 15 cm (6") long. Very tender. Mosaic tolerant Seeds are mottled.

4011 - BEAN BLUE LAKE POLE

57 days

Long vines need supporting. High yields all season long, until frost. White seeds. Reliably straight pods up to 15cm (6") long. Great for freezer storage.

4012 - BEAN BUSH BLUE LAKE

65 days

Big bean flavour, 15cm (6") long straight pods, not stringy. Big bushy plants up to 45cm (18") wide. Home and market garden favourite. White seeds.

4015 - BEET EARLY WONDER TALL TOP

57 days

Semi-globe shaped, smooth skinned, solid flesh. Very sweet and tender, great uniformity and interior quality.

4020 - BEET CYLINDRA

60 days *Heirloom*

Dark red, 15cm (6") cylindrical roots with a sweet flesh and perfect shape for slicing. Excellent keeper, 20cm (8") long. Vitamin rich.

4022 - BEET CHIOGGIA GUARDSMARK

55 days

Red and white concentric bands through roots. Medium sized roots. Early maturing beet. Sweet, mild flavour. Requires less cooking time than most varieties of beet.

4023 - BEET TOUCHSTONE GOLD

53 days

Vibrant orange-red exterior, uniform root shape, mild tasting bright yellow flesh with very little zoning and striking green tops make this specialty beet an eye catching garden treat!

4025 - BROCCOLI GREEN SPROUTING

55 to 80 days *Heirloom*

An old Italian variety that matures early. Large plants grow to 50cm (20") in height, light blue-green heads 20cm (8") across. After harvesting the main head, numerous medium sized lateral heads will form for harvest later in the season.

4027 - BABY PAK CHOI

40 days

Tiny green leaf cabbage. A favourite braised, sautéed or used in stir fries and soups.

4030 - CARROT NANTES

70 days *Heirloom*

Dark orange, 15-17cm (6-7") cylindrical shaped roots with a sweet, yet tender and crisp flesh. Vigorous, early maturity.

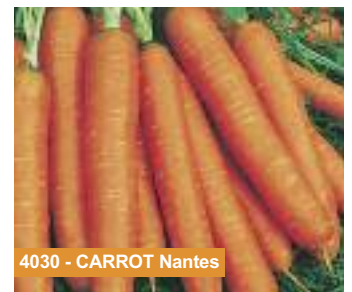

4038 - CORN NATURAL SWEET XR

4040 - CUCUMBER MARKETMORE (SLICER)

67 days
Perfectly shaped, uniform dark green fruits 20cm (8") long. A great tasting, superb slicer and resistant to mosaic and scab.

4045 - CUCUMBER SMR 58 (PICKLER)

64 days *Heirloom*
Black spined, medium green fruits with a taper at both ends. The best disease resistant pickler!

4046 - CUCUMBER HOME MADE PICKLES

55 days
Semi-bush type plants produce a large number of medium green, 12cm (6") fruit. Excellent dill pickling variety. Good disease resistance.

4050 - HERB CHIVES

65 days *Heirloom*
Plants grow in clusters to 15cm (6") high and produce pretty, edible, purple ball-shaped flowers. While it often spreads from established plants by self-seeding, it is not considered invasive. Perennial hardy to zone 3

4055 - HERB CILANTRO

70 days *Heirloom*
Annual. White seeds are used in confection and cookies, poultry stuffing. The fresh leaves are indispensable to Latin American cuisine. Great in salads. Grows to 70cm (28").

4060 - HERB DILL

70 days *Heirloom*
Annual. A pretty plant with lacy foliage growing from 60-75cm (2-2.5') high in the garden. Dill is one of the easiest herbs to grow and can readily self-seed, assuming of course you leave any of the seed heads on the plant!

4065 - HERB OREGANO

90 days *Heirloom*
Strongly aromatic leaves are used in sauces and to flavour meat. Oregano goes hand in hand with most tomato dishes. Grows to 60cm (2'). Oregano is a perennial herb hardy to zone 5 with winter protection.

4067 - HERB SAGE

85 days *Heirloom*
Perennial. Hardy to zone 5. May be direct sown spring or late summer. Height: 60cm (24"). Spread: 90cm (36"). Aromatic. Essential culinary herb.

4070 - HERB SWEET BASIL

85 days *Heirloom*
The "King of Herbs". Useful for flavouring soups, stews, poultry or sauce. Annual. Ht 60cm (2").

4071 - HERB RED RUBIN BASIL

57 days
A variety similar to Dark Opal but with a spicier flavour and red-purple leaves. Originates from India. Reaches 45cm (1.5') tall.

4072 - HERB CULINARY BLEND BASIL

57 days
Special gourmet's blend of four basil varieties Contains: Corsican, Genovese, Lemon and Lime basil.

4075 - HERB GENOVESE BASIL

Heirloom
Spicy flavour just waiting to get out for the perfect pesto every time! Large 5cm (2") dark green leaves; slow bolting; great in containers!

4085 - HERB THYME

Heirloom
You'll find it compliments any meat, shellfish dish, eggs and cheese specialties. A slow growing perennial 15-30cm (6-12") tall.

4087 - KALE RED RUSSIAN

75 days *Heirloom*
Lots of flat, grey-green leaves and purple-red stem. Soft tender texture when braised. Suitable for salads. Winter hardy.

4089 - LEEK GIANT

90 days *Heirloom*.
Medium green with a nicely elongated stem 20-22cm (8-9") long and potentially 5-7cm (2-3") thick. An essential for European cuisine.

4090 - LETTUCE BLACK SEEDED SIMPSON

45 days *Heirloom*
Originated in 1875. Extra large, crumpled, light green leaves. Sow early and often.

4095 - LETTUCE BUTTERCRUNCH

65 days
Butterhead-type. Dark green, crisp, thick leaves surround a yellow-white heart. Tolerant to Bolting & warm temperatures.

4098 - LETTUCE TOM THUMB

34 days *Heirloom*.
Miniature butterhead type, ideal for individual salads. Dark green fleshy outer leaves wrap around a creamy yellow mild-flavored interior. Resists bolting.

4100 - LETTUCE MARVELLE FOUR SEASONS

50 days *Heirloom*
Grown by gardeners for over 100 years. Crisp leaves are creamy yellow to green and often have red fringes on the leaves.

4102 - LETTUCE AMISH DEER TONGUE

31 days *Heirloom*
Medium green triangular leaves make great baby greens. Slight nutty flavor, crunchy heart. Loose upright heads are slow to bolt.

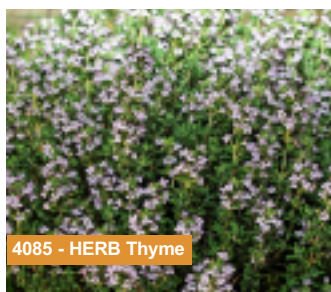

4110 - LETTUCE PARIS ISLAND COS

72 days *Heirloom*
Tall 25cm (10") heads are crisp and sweet with emerald green leaves and a creamy white heart.

4115 - MESCLUN MIXED

A mix of flavours that appeal to any palate. A fiesty blend of organic greens. Fast and easy to grow, even in containers.

4120 - MELON HEART OF GOLD

75 days *Heirloom*
Aromatic, sweet, deep orange fleshed melons 14-16cm (5-7cm) diameter. Thick and firm cavity, green rind, grey outer skin heavily netted. Averages 1.5-2 kg (3-4 lb) weight.

4122 - MUSTARD MIZUNA

40 days *Heirloom*
Mild flavoured Japanese mustard. Very adaptable to any garden. Use fresh greens in salads or add to soups and stir-fries.

4124 - OKRA CLEMSON

57 days *Heirloom*
Most popular okra grown. Metre tall (3') bushes produce dark green, grooved pods without spines. Soak seeds overnight before sowing.

4125 - ONION EVERGREEN BUNCHING

64 days
Green leaved with a long white stalk and mild flavour. Great for salads, soups stews or garnish.

4130 - PARSLEY MOSS CURLED

70 days
Finely cut, crimped, broad, dark green leaves are great for garnishing.

4132 - PARSLEY ITALIAN PLAIN/SINGLE

78 days
Very flat, deeply cut, vibrant dark green leaves may look unassuming, but add it to your favourite dish and taste it come alive with a burst of flavour you didn't expect! Wonderfully rich and flavourful it adds a true European characteristic to any soup or stew.

4135 - PEA LAXTON'S PROGRESS

62 days *Heirloom*
Early maturing, vigorous plants are loaded with 12cm (5") pods bursting with 8-10 sweet, soft skinned peas.

4140 - PEA OREGON SUGAR POD

60 days
Light green flat pods 7-10cm (3-4") long are sweet, succulent right off the vine. Excellent disease resistance, determinate plant habit means no staking.

4145 - PEPPER CALIFORNIA WONDER

Large, thick walled 7-10cm (3-4") diameter fruits are sweet and juicy. Mature green fruits turn red when left on the plant.

4150 - PEPPER LONG RED CAYENNE

75 days *Heirloom*

Medium hot chili pepper. Long, slender, wrinkled peppers, 12 cm x 1.25 cm (5" x 1/2") size with a tapered end. Green fruits ripen crimson-red. Excellent for drying or pickling.

4152 - PEPPER JALEPENO

75 days

Medium hot. The famous hot pepper of Mexican food. Prolific producer. Sturdy, bushy plants. All you need is garden with lots of full sun. Benefits from fertilizing & compost.

4155 - PUMPKIN BIG MAX

120 days

Large, sized, exhibition weight pumpkins up 45kg (100lb) size. Thick, slight red-orange skin with bright yellow-orange flesh. Needs lots of room for the vines to ramble. Plant in full sun where there's good air circulation. Fertilizing and adequate irrigation are essential for contest quality pumpkins.

4160 - PUMPKIN SMALL SUGAR

120 days *Heirloom*

Round fruits 20-25 cm (8"-10") diameter with sweet, meaty, bright orange fine-grained flesh. Great for pies.

4162 - RADISH SPARKLER

23 days

A beautiful round radish. The top half is a fine scarlet colour with a rosy edge bordering a pure white bottom half. Tender yet crisp flesh.

4165 - RADISH CHERRY BELL.

25 days

Very sweet, mild with a solid crisp white flesh. A good keeper.

4167 - RADISH DAIKON

25 days

Long tap rooted white radish. A favourite in Japanese and Korean cookery. Sow spring and late summer.

4169 - RADISH EASTER EGG BLEND

30 days

Looking to add beauty and distinction to salads? Easter Egg Blend offers an eclectic mix of white, red, purple and pink coloured globe-shaped roots. Medium to large size roots have a smooth skin and crisp interior flesh with mild, delicate flavour. Slow to develop pithiness.

4170 - RADISH FRENCH BREAKFAST

23 days *Heirloom*

Long, scarlet-red roots 10-15cm (4-6") size with white tips and surprisingly sweet taste.

4175 - SPINACH BLOOMSDALE

47 days *Heirloom*

Heavy yielding, heat and cold tolerant. Slow bolting too! Sow early spring or late fall. Sow every two weeks for continuous harvest. Thin seedlings to 5-7.5cm (2-3") after germination

4180 - SQUASH BURGESS BUTTERCUP

87 days *Heirloom*

The skin is dark green with narrow grey stripes and slight mottling. Strong growing vines. Growing conditions may produce boxy shaped fruits and at other times they can be similar in shape to an acorn. Very interesting looking and very flavourful winter squash.

4182 - SQUASH WALTHAM BUTTERNUT

90 days

An excellent winter squash. Creamy-yellow coloured fruit has a small seed cavity and a bulbous end with solid, smooth skin and deep orange flesh. A large, vigorous growing vine and heavy producer. The already great taste will improve with storage!

4185 - SQUASH DARK GREEN ZUCCHINI

50 days

Summer squash. This bushy variety produces enough delicious, dark green fruits to feed the nation! Harvest fruit for best quality when 25-30cm (10-12") long. Very easy to grow in half whisky-barrel

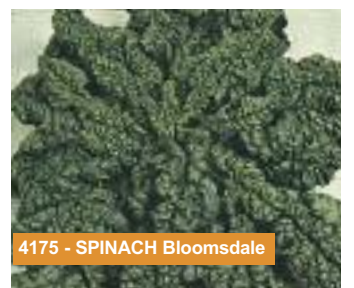

4190 - SQUASH TABLE QUEEN

80 days *Heirloom*
Hard, dark green fruits 15cm (6") diameter with tasty, very sweet, pale yellow flesh. Some gardeners report success with seed sown indoors with bottom heat. Only transplant to the garden when soil temperatures are above 15C (60F). This squash is an excellent keeper!



4192 - SQUASH Golden Zucchini

4192 - SQUASH GOLDEN ZUCCHINI

50 days
Bright yellow cylindrical fruits with bright green stems. Best picked when 17cm x 3cm (7"x 1.5") size. Pick fruit that are firm and straight with little curving or bulging. Great tasting creamy white flesh. Prolific summer squash.

4198 - TOMATO Beefsteak

4195 - SWISS CHARD FORDHOOK GIANT

50 days
Huge, glossy dark green white veined leaves are fleshy, Maintain sufficient soil moisture to keep plants from wilting. Try carefully removing leaves from the root crown. By doing this, new leaves will sprout for harvesting all summer long.

4197 - SWISS CHARD RAINBOW

90 days
Brightly coloured stems of yellow, crimson, gold, orange, violet, purple, white, green and pink, with dark green, crinkled leaves. Leaves have a lighter taste than the standard chards. Often used as an ornamental in flower gardens.

4200 - TOMATO Brandywine

4198 - TOMATO BEEFSTEAK

62 days
A reliable and consistent producer of bright juicy red tomatoes 260g (9oz) size with a deliciously sweet, firm interior. Still one of the most popular tomatoes grown by home gardeners everywhere. Indeterminate plants require staking.

4200 - TOMATO BRANDYWINE

80 days *Heirloom*
Amish heirloom from 1895. Many say it is the best eating tomato ever. You be the judge. Deeply lobed, purplish-red Beefsteak type fruits, 250g-300g (12oz) size. Potato like leaves. Ready 80 days from transplant.

4201 - TOMATO SAN MARZANO

80 days
Classic Italian plum tomato for sauce and canning. Large bright red fruits. Contains few seeds and slightly flattened sides, average 150g (6 oz) size. Outer skin is crack resistant, interior flesh is meaty and mild. Indeterminate plants require staking.

4202 - TOMATO MONEYMAKER

72 days
Smooth uniform fruits 160g (6oz.) weight and 5cm (2") diameter. Indeterminate plants up to 200cm (80") height. Staking required. This tomato has surprised and amazed gardeners since introduction in 1960. Excellent yields outdoors, and in greenhouse.

4205 - TOMATO SWEETIE

50 days
Small 2.5cm (1") (approximate size) fruits form in clusters on long branches. This semi determinate variety should be staked for maximum production. Eat fresh from the garden. When this variety starts to produce, you had better get the wheelbarrow out -- you will need it to haul in the crop!

4207 - WATERMELON SUGAR BABY

75 days
Round, sweet tasting fruits 20cm (8") diameter that average 4-5kg (9-11lb) weight. Seeds require 5-10 days at a soil temperature of 24C (75F) to germinate. Sow 6-8 seeds per hill, 12mm (1/2") deep in hills spaced 1.8-2.4m (6-8') from each other. Thin to 3-4 plants per hill. Never let the plants lack for water.
